Who?

Who wrote the article and who published it? Look at the 'About' page and search online and see what you can find out about them.

When?

When was the last update posted? Use the most up-to-date version that you can find.

Where?

Can you find the same information from another, unrelated source?

Why?

Does the article push a particular point of view? You need the whole story
